




UW Bothell is the largest of the five branch campuses in the state of Washington.

More than a quarter of all UW Bothell students come from Snohomish county.



42% of UW Bothell students are students of color from diverse backgrounds.

Ninety-one percent of UW Bothell students are from the state of Washington.



Discovery Hall, home of UW Bothell's School of STEM, will open for classes in fall quarter 2014.

Transfer applications to UW Bothell increased by 21 percent over 2012. First year applications increased by 5 percent.



46% of first year students are first-generation students.

UW Bothell students received a record number of merit scholarships in 2012-13, including two student Fulbright Awards.



UW Bothell welcomed 29 new faculty members in 2013, its largest new faculty class ever.

A new \$19.7-Million Student Activities Center will open in 2014.
