a. Chancellor Chan

Kevin King thanked Chancellor Chan for the funding of transportation to Seattle meetings

Chancellor discusses why he stepped down

Keen on setting strategic goals

Important to know that Universities go through stages

UW Bothell has been placed as a major University player

The next 5-7 years is the time for a new phase of growth in the University

The institution needs someone here for 7-10 years, thus now is a good time to step down because that much time can't be committed at this time

Chancellor has really enjoyed being a part of building UW Bothell

Search Committee is being formed (it will include students, faculty, staff, other campuses, members of the UW Bothell advisory board, and others)

Search Firm is hired

Jaelyn brought up course fees and the Regents

Chancellor says that generally speaking, the Regents will take our recommendation

Course fee is like requiring a specific book

Course fees are in no way at all a slippery slope towards differential tuition

Shahin brings up the point that if we don't go with differential tuition and if UW Seattle does, that could threaten the perception of a UW Bothell degree

The Chancellor does not agree with this viewpoint—doesn't want to simply charge more just for appearances

Jodi brings up the point that while people do tend to make decisions based on feelings largely over facts, we need to work on developing the Community's views of UW Bothell to understand that even if UW Seattle does move towards differential tuition and charges more, UW Bothell is just as good of an education

Tal brings up the fact that wouldn't differential tuition benefit the education of the UW Bothell community as whole due to the quality all around the board?

The Chancellor stated that we must keep our minds open to the idea of differential tuition because good points could be raised
