Housing Timeline

The housing application priority date is **May 1st**. Both the application and a \$50 application fee must be received for the application to be considered complete. After the priority date, applications will be accepted on a space available basis.

Housing Information

The University of Washington Bothell now offers student housing:

- Large, furnished one-and two bedroom units
- The buildings are co-ed; roommates will be of the same sex
- Close to shopping, restaurants, and bus lines
- Student life programming specifically designed for the residential community
- Undergraduate community advisors and a Resident Director is on call 24 hours a day to respond to emergencies
- Bothell police and fire within a mile of all student housing

Housing is available to currently enrolled University of Washington Bothell students who are 18 years of age or older. If you will be turning 18 during the 2010-11 academic year, you are eligible to live in University housing.

Housing is assigned based on the following priority order:

- Current Student Housing Residents
- New Freshmen who live at least 30 miles from campus (including Whidbey Island)
- New Freshmen who live within 30 miles from campus.
- New Transfer Students who live at least 30 miles from campus (including Whidbey Island)
- Continuing undergraduate students who live at least 30 miles from campus (including Whidbey Island)
- New Transfer Students who live within 30 miles from campus.
- All continuing undergraduate students within 30 miles from campus.
- Graduate students.

Within each priority category the University has the right to prioritize based on the distance between the student's permanent address and campus.
