Program Title: Student Entrepreneur's Network

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### **Executive Summary**

The Student Entrepreneur's Network is seeking the funds needed to expand student involvement. The club participates in an annual entrepreneurship retreat which we would like to get funded. This would increase student involvement and sense of belonging to the club and entrepreneurship in general.

Students need to see how successful entrepreneurs have started their businesses. It's important to know how realistic it can be to start your own business rather than working for another person. Students need to realize that there is a thriving entrepreneurial community in the area which wants to see them start successful companies.

Attendance at the club's weekly meetings has varied from 10 to 40 people. Two measures of success are the number of students attending the meetings and the number of students who return as alumni.

This year the club has spent its money on funding a professional email and contact management service (\$150) and covering student registrations for the entrepreneurship retreat (\$1,300). These activities have allowed us to keep in touch with students and discount their participation in an event which many successful entrepreneurs attend.

It's estimated that 40-80 students will be touched by one of the club's activities next year. The weekly meetings often draw students for the first time. Once students start coming to the meetings we involve them in more activities such as the retreat.

We plan to fund 40 students' registration fees next year allowing us to significantly impact their ability to attend the retreat. The planned spring dinner will impact all students who choose to attend and network. It will be heavily advertised by word of mouth and by the club.

Financial support for this club comes exclusively from the SAF committee.

3. **In 150 words or less**, please describe the benefits that participants are likely to gain by attending or participating in this program or service.

Students will gain a new social and business network to learn from. Many of our members attend meetings for the social aspect while others solely for talking business. Students will benefit greatly from meeting a diverse group of entrepreneurs and professionals. Benefits include but aren't limited to:

- Critiquing business plans
- Getting their business ideas and plans critiqued
- Gaining a greater appreciation for the challenge of starting a business
- Speaking with successful entrepreneurs
- Meeting and socializing with other students
- Networking with alumni
