

## Payments

Please **return enclosed coupons** with payments. Be sure to keep a record of your payments and due dates as we are **not** able to send out reminders.

Credit cards and online web checks are **not** accepted with the first two payments of the Tuition Payment Plan – only checks and cash for the exact amounts detailed in this pamphlet. However, for the final payment, credit cards or web checks online are acceptable means of payment.

### Payment Deadlines

- 1<sup>st</sup> Payment:** September 30, 2011
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Payment:** October 14, 2011
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Payment:** October 28, 2011

Payments must either be made:

- At the UWB Cashier by 5:00pm on the due date.
- By mail, **must be received by the due date.** Postmarked with the due date will not be accepted.
- In the drop boxes located in the lobby on the promenade level of UW1 & UW2 **by 4:00 p.m. on the due date. No cash. Only checks accepted in the drop boxes.**

Payments made after the second and third due dates will be assessed a \$55.00 late fee for **each** late payment.

If your bank returns your payment as unpaid for any reason, you will be charged a fee of \$25.00 per returned item.

**NOTE: If you are up-to-date on your Tuition Payment Plan, please ignore late payment statement notifications you receive via e-mail.**
