MINIMUM UNIVERSITY ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Minimum cumulative GPA: 2.0
- World Language
 - 2 quarters at the college level *or*
 - 2 years in high school
- Intermediate Algebra
 - Intermediate Algebra with a 2.0 in college *or*
 - 3 years of math in high school, including Intermediate Algebra
- English Proficiency (*if required*)

PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

- Minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5
- Minimum prerequisite GPA of 2.5
- Minimum prerequisite grade of 2.0 in all prerequisite courses
- 7 out of 9 prerequisite courses completed at time of application (max. 2 in progress)
- Writing Skills Assessment or qualifying SAT/ACT or TOEFL/IELTS score:
uwb.edu/babusiness/admission-requirements/assessment (WSA scores valid for 2 years; SAT/ACT scores valid for 5 years; TOEFL/IELTS scores valid for 2 years)
- Current resume

COMPETITIVE APPLICANTS

Applicants who are generally competitive to Business will have the following:

1. Prerequisite GPA of 3.0
2. Cumulative college GPA of 3.0
3. Minimum WSA score of 3.0 (or qualifying SAT/ACT score or TOEFL/IELTS score)
4. A positive grade trend with few to no repeats
