ADMISSIONS CHECKLIST TO THE SCHOOL OF BUSINESS

Bothell and Eastside Leadership Center (ELC)

1. REVIEW SCHOOL OF BUSINESS PREREQUISITES

To be eligible to apply to the UW Bothell School of Business a student must:

Complete 60 transferrable credits (80 preferred) with a 2.5 minimum GPA to include the following business program prerequisites. Two of the following classes may be in progress at the time of your Winter and Spring application. Three may be in progress at the time of your Autumn application.

- Advance Composition
 - Microeconomics *
 - Macroeconomics
 - Business Law
 - Statistics *
 - Calculus *
 - Financial Accounting (I and II) *
 - Managerial Accounting
- * prefer completed prior to applying

2. REGISTER FOR THE WRITING SKILLS ASSESSMENT TEST (WSA)

The WSA can only be taken once per application period and should be completed before applying to the School of Business.

To register, go to uwb.edu/babusiness/admission-requirements/assessmentreg

TESTING PERIODS;

- **Autumn:** March - July
- **Winter:** July - October
- **Spring:** January - February

NOTE: A SAT-Essay/SAT-Writing or an ACT-Writing score meeting minimum requirements may be used in lieu of a WSA score if less than 5 years old. WSA scores are valid for 2 years. TOEFLE/IELTS scores accepted in lieu of a WSA score.
