Timeline of Development of Office of CBLR at UW Bothell, 2001-2018

2001-2004	Faculty and staff develop and present a series of proposals for a Center for Community Engagement
2007-2008	Faculty constitute a CBLR fellows program as a faculty development/learning circle, with some funding. Continues to the present to run as an annual fellowship program.
2007-2008	Interdisciplinary Arts and Sciences (IAS) program hires Michelle Cruver Alejano as Community Relations Coordinator; campus discusses possibility of an equivalent campus position
November 2008	IAS Community Relations Coordinator Michelle Cruver Alejano departs
2009-2012	Karen Ericson (Business) hired as a .8 FTE staff director of Office of CBLR on soft money; funding and position are renewed annually until 2012. Office housed within the Teaching and Learning Center
2009-2013	Office of CBLR benefits from a series of yearly Americorps positions through Washington State Campus Compact. Kara Adams serves as the first
2010-2011	Office of CBLR hires Kara Adams as Community Partnerships Coordinator, on soft money
2011-2013	Kara leaves position for graduate study; Kelsen Caldwell hired to cover these responsibilities as a Graduate Staff Assistant (50%) while a student in the MA in Cultural Studies program
2012-2013	Office of CBLR benefits from a full-time MLK Vista positions sponsored by Solid Ground, to support the Bothell Youth Court and MATCH (Making Access to College Happen)
January 2012	Karen Ericson's position as Director of CBLR is not renewed
August 2012	UW Bothell does a national search for a Director of the Office of CBLR; hires Paul Markham.
January 2013	Markham assumes position as Director of Office of CBLR, reporting to Vice Chancellor for Academic Affairs
June 2013	Kara Adams hired as Assistant Director of Office of CBLR
September 2013	Office of CBLR moved to Student Success Center
January 2014	Markham position refigured as Director of Community Partnerships and Engagement, reporting to the Chancellor; Furco/Holland review and report commissioned
April 2014	Markham departs UW Bothell; Adams becomes Interim Director of Office of CBLR
January 2015	Community Engagement Task Force convened and charged
January 2016	Community Engagement Task Force report and recommendations released
February 2016	Community Engagement Council charged
September 2016	UW Bothell does a national search for a Director of Community Engagement; hires Kara Adams
January 2017	Adams assumes position as Director of Community Engagement, reporting to Director of Integrated Learning under Academic Affairs
November 2017	Office of CBLR is reorganized to report to the Director of the Teaching and Learning Center under Academic Affairs
January 2018	Layla Taylor hired as Community-Based Learning and Research Program Manager
