Students must declare the minor before or at the time that a graduation application is completed. Students must complete the following requirements (with a minimum grade of 2.0 in each course) for a minor in Diversity Studies:

*To be approved, the Final Project course (s) must link theory and practice in a way that is appropriate to the learning objectives of the minor. The requirement may be fulfilled by an appropriate course offered in any school or program, and may satisfy multiple requirements at once (e.g. the course may satisfy both IAS's *Interdisciplinary Practice and Reflection* requirement and the *Diversity Studies Final Project* requirement).
