Multiple Start Dates

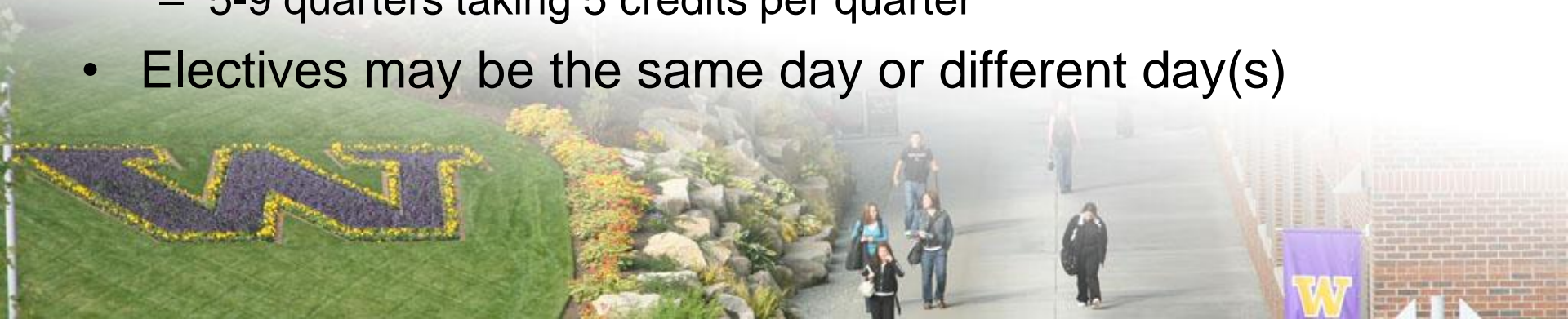
- **Everett Location:**
 - Autumn and Winter start
- **Bothell Location:**
 - Summer and Autumn start
 - May be admitted any quarter as an Pre-BSN student
- **Seattle Location:**
 - Autumn start



Designed for the Working Nurse

Nursing core classes held once per week

- **Everett:**
 - Tuesdays
- **Bothell:**
 - Summer start-choose between Tuesday or Thursday
 - Autumn start-Thursdays
- **Seattle:**
 - Mondays
- **Full and part time options available at the Bothell location:**
 - 4 quarters taking between 9-11 credits each quarter
 - 5-9 quarters taking 5 credits per quarter
- **Electives may be the same day or different day(s)**

- 90 transferable credits
- NCLEX completion (or admitted conditionally)
- University admission requirements

- Apply online directly to the RN-to-BSN program
- Personal Statement
- Resume
- Three program recommendations
 - Online or paper recommendations
- Educational transcripts



Application Deadlines

- Summer start: January 15th
- Autumn start: May 15th
- Winter start: October 1st
- Priority Admissions: October 1st for Summer and Autumn
 - [Must meet eligibility requirements](#)
- FAFSA: February 28th for summer, fall and winter start dates.
- Have all application material submitted by the deadline to ensure review!

priority application due date: March 1

- Bachelor Degree
- RN Licensure
- Last 90 college credits with 3.0 GPA or higher
- College statistics with 2.0 or higher
