Cram Nights is a program that ASUWB works with CCC Student Government (CSG) and the Chancellor's office to host. Historically, this event has provided students with extended library hours, which allows students to study late hours in the library. ASUWB is seeking to expand the Cram Night program to be more than just a study environment, but to hold some educational workshops as well.

Cram Nights have historically attracted over 250 students, from both UWB and CCC. Since Cram Nighs is entering it's third year of programming, ASUWB has decided to revitalize the program. In addition to offering students extended library hours, ASUWB would like to coordinate some workshops with the UW Bothell TLC and the CCC Open Learning Center and would invite UW Bothell Alumni to present on topics. For example, an alumni could present on how they have used their UW Bothell degree or how to use your degree in the work field. ASUWB would like to provide food for students as they are studying and attending	

	these sessions/talks. Students will be in the library till 1 am and having food and coffee available will support students and allow them to stay in the library and focus on studying and learning instead of leaving campus from the lack of food options.

The number of students coming and leaving the library are counted multiple times during the night by the library staff as well as by electronic counters at the doors. These numbers are compiled and evaluated at the end of every quarter by ASUWB and the Library.

This event will be open to all UW Bothell and CCC students.
