Project Title

Digital Video for K-12 Classrooms

Brief Project Overview

Digital video equipment would provide Education students a mechanism for creating instructional resources, learn techniques to support K-12 students' learning of digital video production, document their teaching for required professional reflection, and communicate with families about classroom activities.

The equipment would also allow UW Bothell Education Program field instructors to videotape observations of the teacher certification interns in their field placements in the schools.

A. The goal of the program or project

The goals of this project are to enable all Education students –whether they own their own equipment or not -- to:

- develop skills in video production to develop instructional resources,
- learn to better teach video projects in K-12 schools, (see related STF proposal on Macintosh/Digital Audio-Video Production for Classroom Teachers)
- document classroom practice for formal evaluation, portfolio development, and home-school communication.

B. A description of the program and how it will benefit the student body

K-12 teacher interns must become adept at digital video production, yet many students cannot afford their own equipment. Access to equipment in the schools in which they do their field placements is typically very limited. With over 100 interns enrolled in the Teacher Certification program each quarter (and with internship schedules that often keep them off campus for days), Teacher Certification students cannot readily access Media Center equipment when they need it.

Further, field instructors who observe and critique interns in their classrooms multiple times over the quarter need ready access to digital video equipment for recording and reviewing observations with interns and Master Teachers.
