


Citing Work and Avoiding Plagiarism - An Online Workshop Hosted by Jacqueline Richards

Tips from the ABLE Writing Coach




Getting back into the groove of writing can be challenging. At times it might be frustrating to get started and stay motivated. Here are some tips that have helped me as a student successfully start and finish writing assignments:

- 1. Break down the assignment. Going through the assignment instructions and highlighting requirements can help ensure that nothing gets left out. Make sure to consider the audience and purpose of the assignment. If unsure about assignment guidelines, reach out to the instructor or me.
- 2. Get feedback. A fresh perspective can aid the writing process by bringing in new ideas and catching things that got overlooked. Meeting with me can be a useful way to get feedback.
- 3. Make time to revise. Starting early and giving ourselves time in between drafts to revise allows for stronger drafts
