BHLTH 421 A, Food and Culture, 5 credits, Arts & Humanities SLN: 14142

Description: Through writing, video, storytelling, and creative exploration, examines the forces that shape our choices about food, and how food choices drive our economy, our health, our self-image, and our social connections.

BHLTH 426 A, Intersectionality and Health, 5 credits, Arts & Humanities SLN:10342

Description: Explores intersectionality through historical and contemporary literature, art, the social sciences and the health sciences. Examines the impact of intersectionality (multiple and intersecting identities and social structures) on health.
