<u>The Elementary Education option admits students once per year</u>. The application is due during Autumn Quarter, and the School of Educational Studies hosts workshops in October to aid in a successful application process.

Applying to Elementary Education Option
(Must be admitted to Educational Studies major before applying)

Internal Elementary Education Option application deadline: December 1st for Spring Quarter start Number of prerequisites that can be in progress at the time of application: 15 cr. How to Apply:

- Online application opens in Autumn Quarter.
- Complete at least 2 Educational Studies Core Courses (B EDUC 205, 210, 300, and 310)
- Earn a 3.0 GPA across all Education coursework
- Complete a majority of Academic Breadth coursework (or have them in-progress)
- Respond to essay question prompts (questions on <u>website</u>)
- Submit a Professional Teaching Resume (Work with <u>Career Services</u> for help developing this.)
- Submit letters of recommendation (see <u>website</u> for specifics)
- Complete 20 hours of experience in a public elementary school, paid or volunteer
- Complete the Reading, Writing, & Math sections of the SAT/ACT/WEST-B
