

TUITION REDUCTION FOR VETERANS

ELIGIBILITY: You are eligible to pay reduced tuition and fees if you are a Washington domiciliary who was an active or reserve member of the United States military or naval forces, or a national guard member called to active duty, who served in active federal service, under either Title 10 or Title 32 of the United States Code, in a war or conflict fought on foreign soil or in international waters or in another location in support of those serving on foreign soil or in international waters, and if discharged from service, has received an honorable discharge.

CONDITIONS: The waiver is awarded only to undergraduate students pursuing their first bachelor's degree, to a maximum of 225 college-level credits, including credits transferred from other institutions of higher education. For additional information, please refer to the Washington Administrative Code (WAC), section 478-160-163.

PROCEDURES: Complete the application section below and attach a copy of your DD-214 or other supporting documentation showing your qualifying service, and, if not classified as a Washington resident for tuition purposes, a signed Certification of Washington Domicile.
