- Transfer Credits The University of Washington Bothell allows 135 credits to transfer. Of those, up to 90 credits may be lower division courses (100-200 level). You may petition to have more lower division credits transfer.
- Cross-Campus Enrollment After earning a certain number of credits at UW Bothell (usually 15), students may take up to 15 of their credits per academic year at other UW campuses.
- **Senior Residency** To earn a degree from The University of Washington, students must complete 45 of their final 60 credits at their home campus (UW Bothell is your home campus).
- Minimum GPA All degree-specific requirements must be completed with a grade of 2.0 or higher. In addition, you must maintain a GPA of 2.0 to earn a degree from UW Bothell.
